I imagine these objects to be birthed from a distant yet more-than-human world where my racialized body can exist outside of imposed epistemologies and ways of being. Together with these objects, they become my companions as they are grounded in the physical space that we share. My work is synonymous to the embodied experience that encompasses my daily life-distant memories, feelings of yearning and longing, and a curiosity for the unknown become important characters and driving force in my practice. Currently, I am preoccupied with exploring post-colonialism and decoloniality.




